

# Dean Lewis N. Jones S C H O L A R S H I P

Benefitting Brothers of the Beta Sigma Chapter of Alpha Phi Omega at Texas Tech University

In 1978 Dean Jones retired from Texas Tech University as the Dean of Students. He served over 29 years as an Advisor and Advisory Chairman for the Beta Sigma Chapter and 18 years on the Alpha Phi Omega National Board of Directors where he accomplished

many things. In recognition for his service, Dean Jones was awarded the Fraternity's highest honor – the National Distinguished Service Key – in 1964 and was named the Fall 1978 National Pledge Class Honoree.

A native of Cleburne, TX, Dean Jones received both his Bachelors and Masters degrees from Texas Tech University where he lettered in football. He played professionally for the 1943 Brooklyn Dodgers before serving in the Navy in World War II.

Many awards and honors were bestowed upon Dean Jones over the years, signifying the high esteem in which he was held. His quiet, yet firm, manner , his patient guidance and his sense of commitment to that which he was involved, left the lives he touched far richer from the experience. Thisis especially true of the Brothers of Beta Sigma Chapter, which is why a small group of alumni lead by Brothers Tony Gustwick and Bill Riley established this scholarship in 2003 in honor of the Dean's 90th birthday with many more contributing over the years, including in his memory after his death in 2006. Many Beta Sigma Alumni continue the tradition today by contributing annually.

Today, a student member is selected each semester based on their leadership and loyalty to the Beta Sigma Chapter among other factors. As Dean Jones said many times: **Be A Leader. Be A Friend. Be of Service. May the Beta Sigma Chapter ever stand united.** 

## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Dean Lewis N. Jones Scholarship is a one-time award of \$1500 given each Fall and Spring semester. The amount was increased from \$500 to \$1000 in Spring 2019 by generous alumni gathered for Beta Sigma's 80th Anniversary Celebration and again in Spring 2022. The Scholarship may only be won one time per student. Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, ethnicity, gender or sexual orientation and administered by the Texas Tech Alumni Association.

#### **CRITERIA FOR APPLICANTS**

- Must be an active member in good standing of the Beta Sigma Chapter of Alpha Phi Omega
- Must not be a graduating senior
- Must be a full time student, currently enrolled for a minimum of 12 hours or more
- Must be returning to Texas Tech University next semester as an undergraduate student
- Must not have previously been awarded this same scholarship

All students meeting this criteria may continue to apply.
